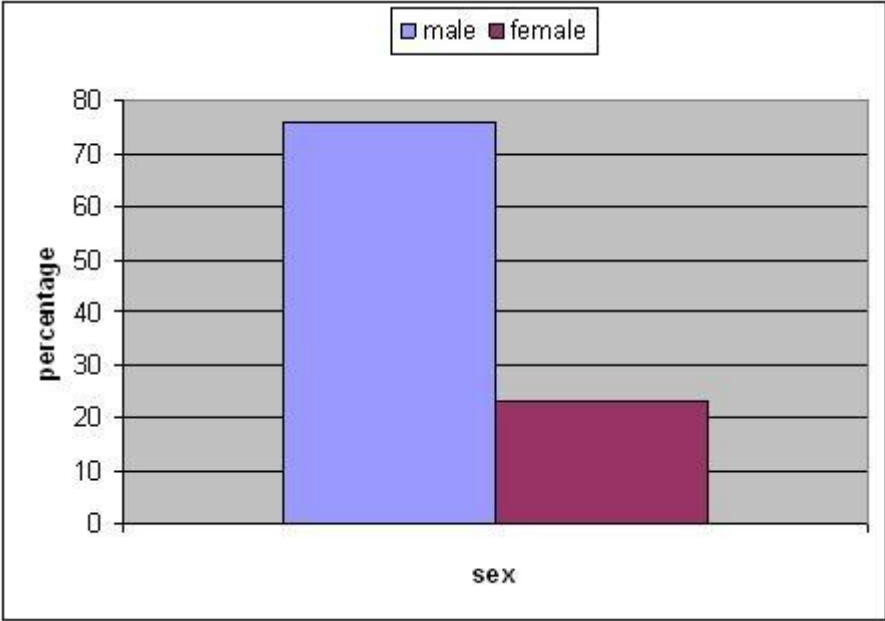

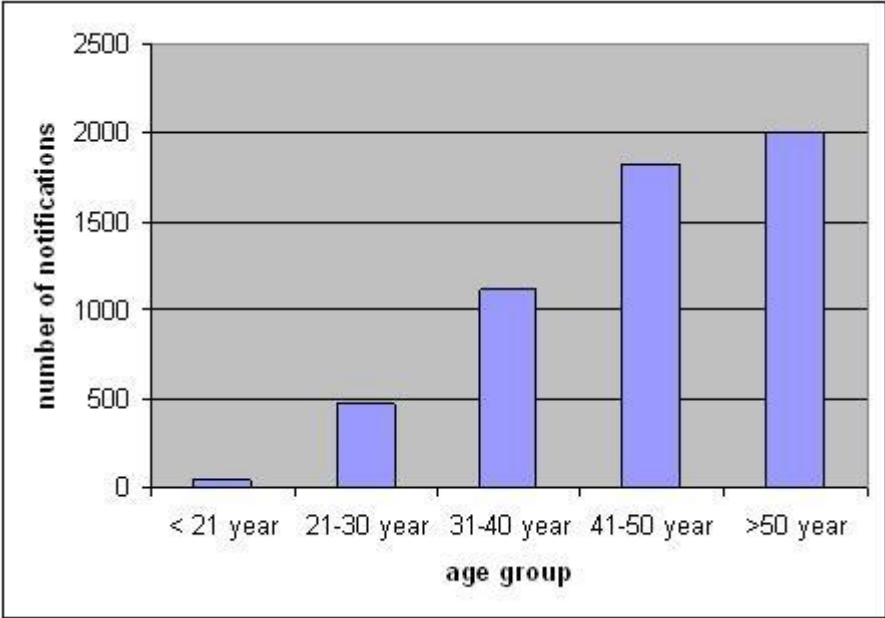

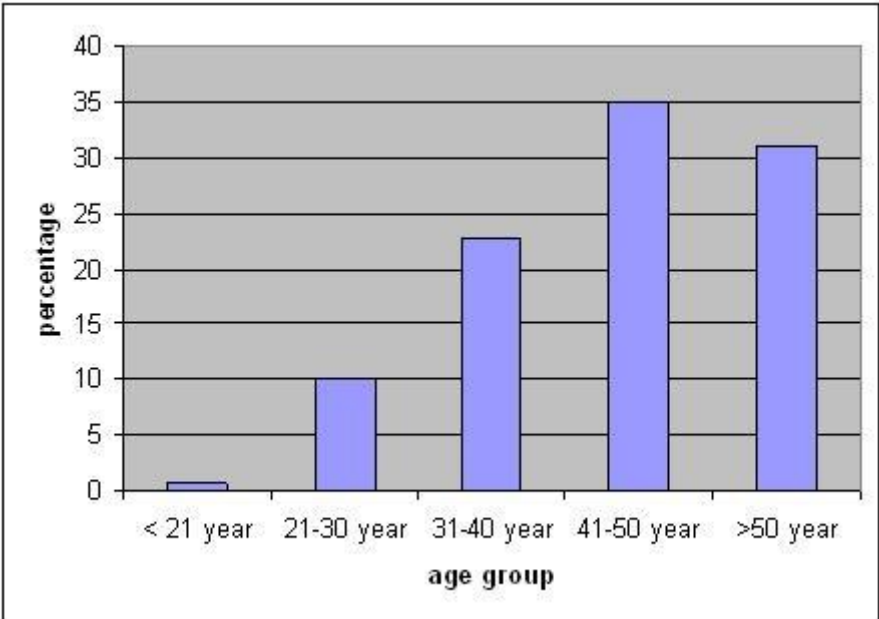

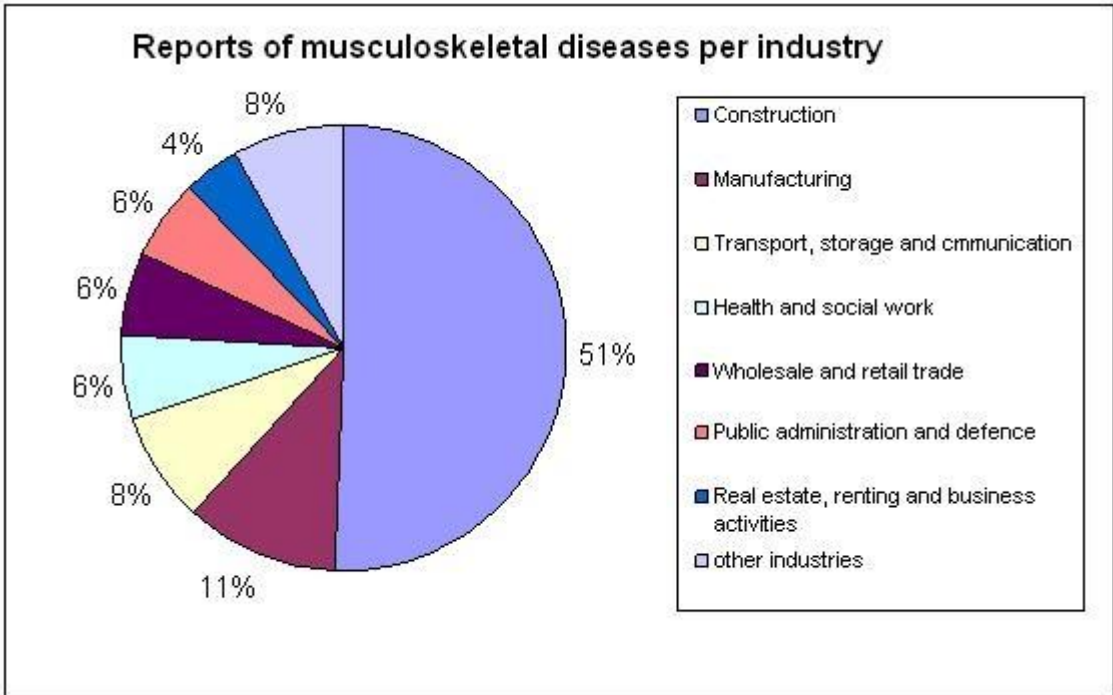
This figure shows the number of reports of disorders of posture and musculoskeletal system in the National Registry of Occupational Diseases per age group in 2006

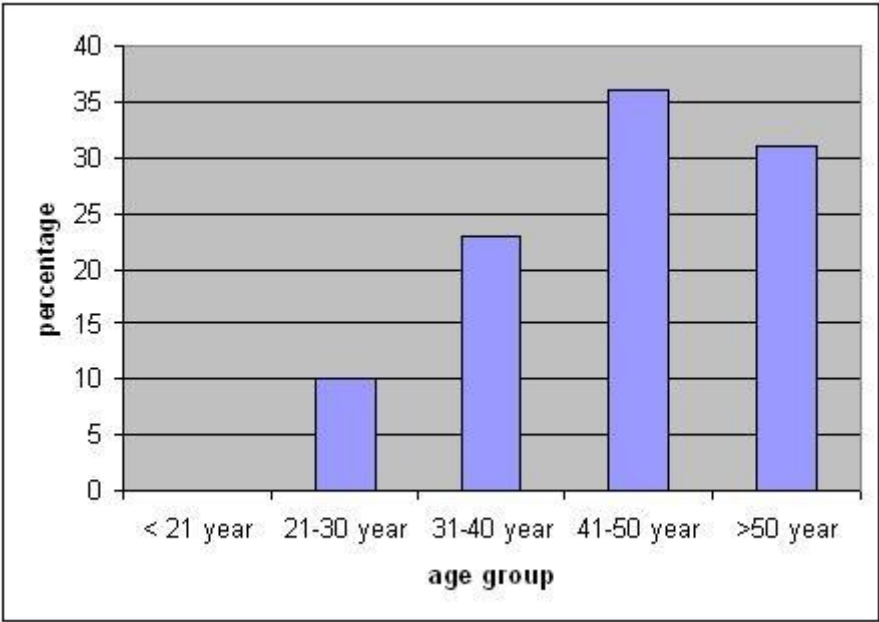

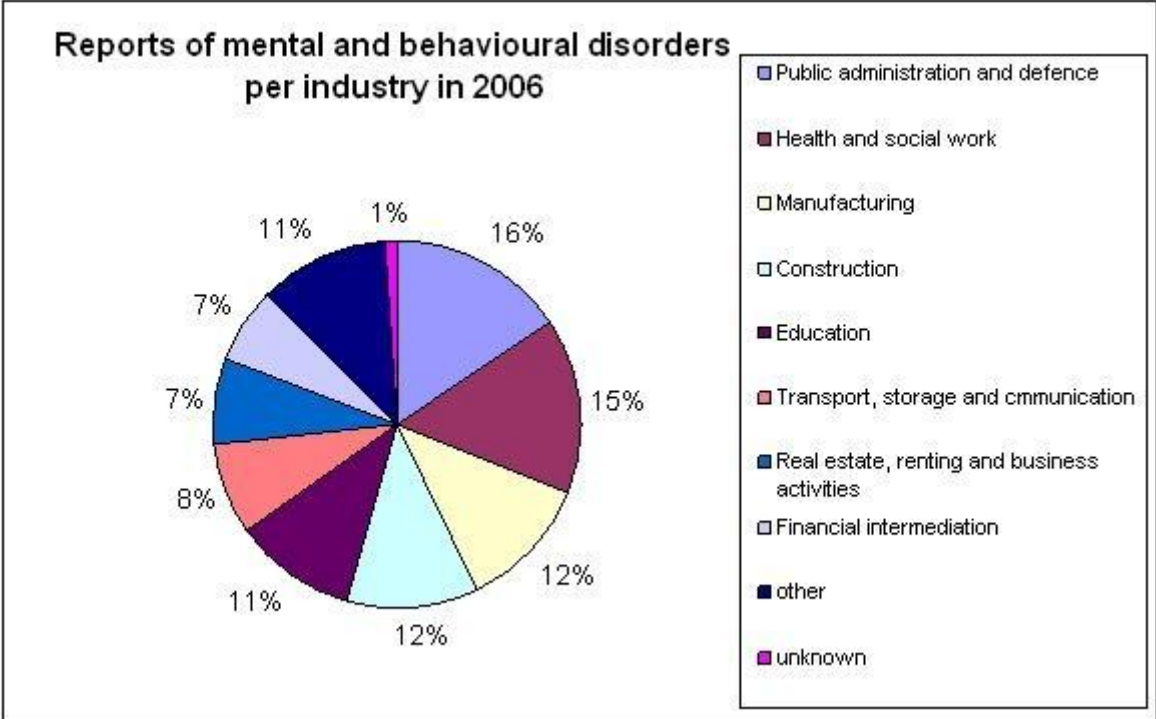
This figure shows the number of reports of psychological disorders in the National Registry of Occupational Diseases per age group in 2006

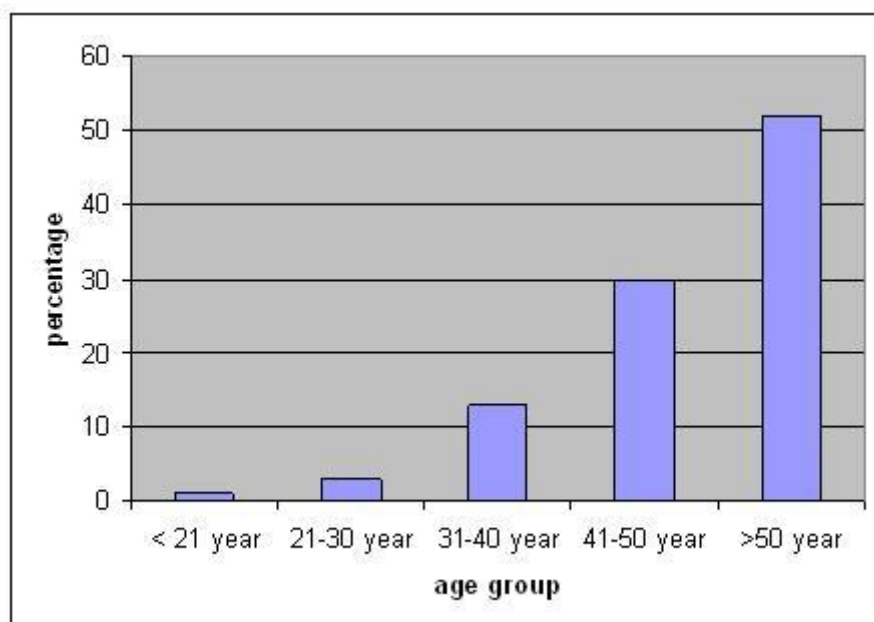

## Diseases of the ear and mastoid process per age group in 2006

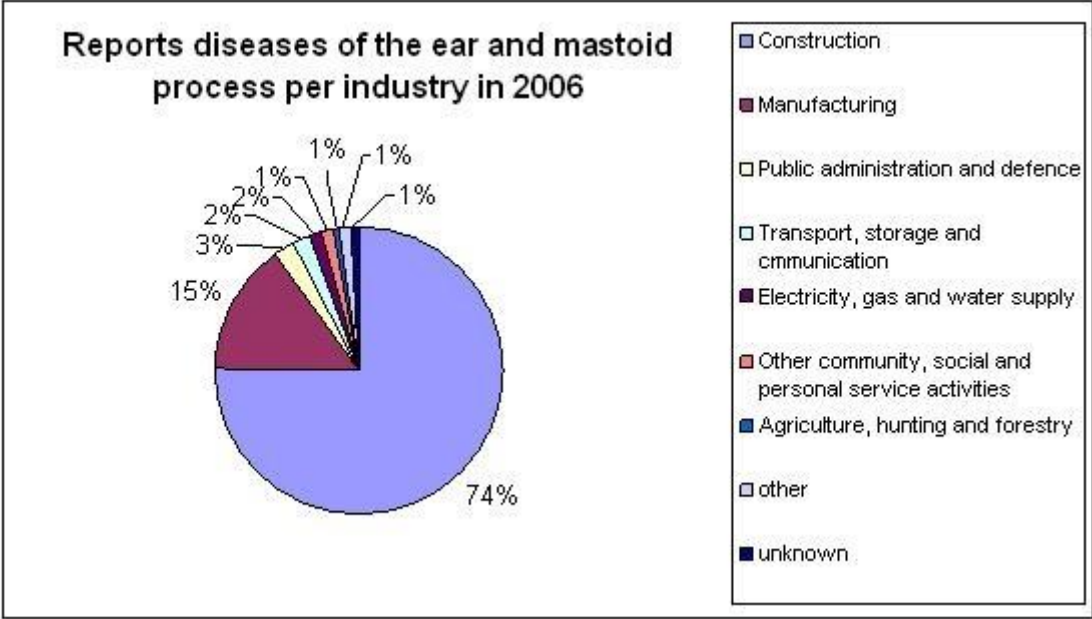
This figure shows the number of reports of diseases of the ear and mastoid process in the National Registry of Occupational Diseases per age group in 2006

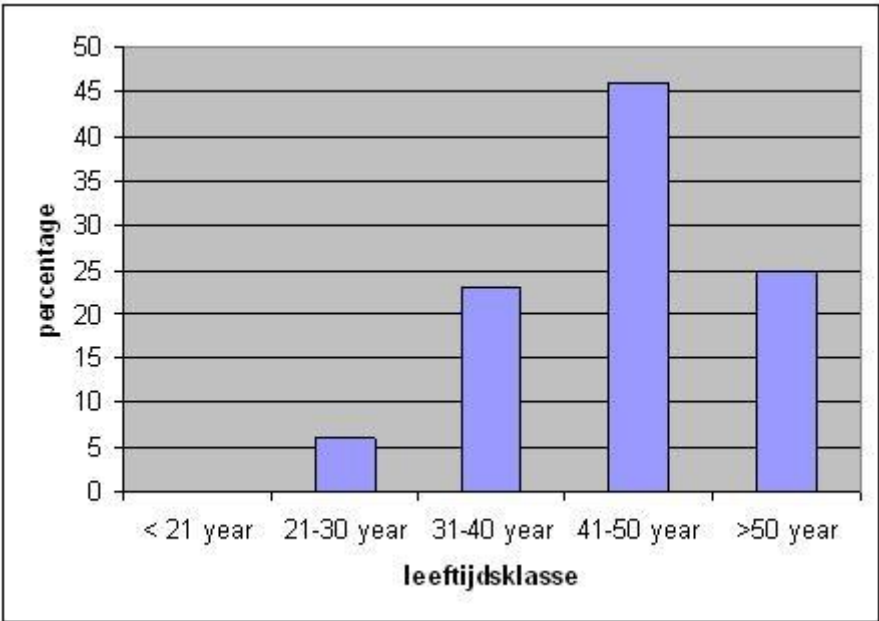

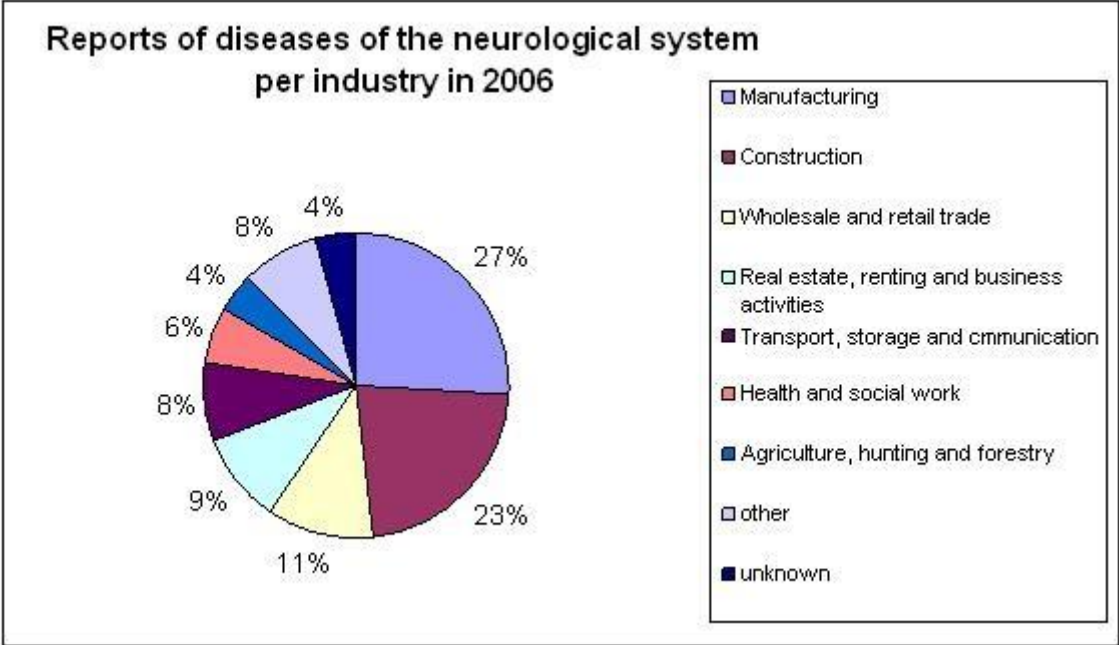
This figure shows the number of reports of neurological disorders in the National Registry of Occupational Diseases per age group in 2006

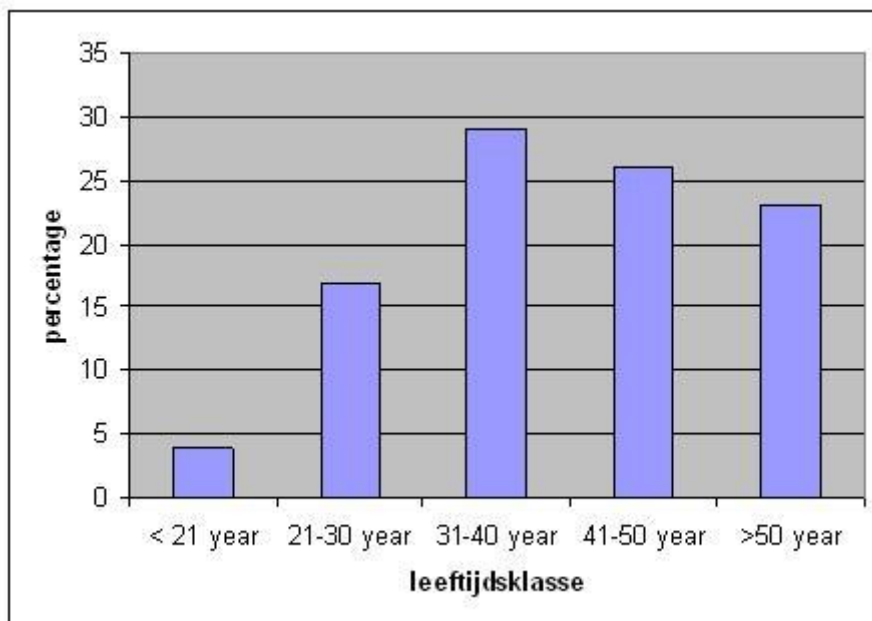

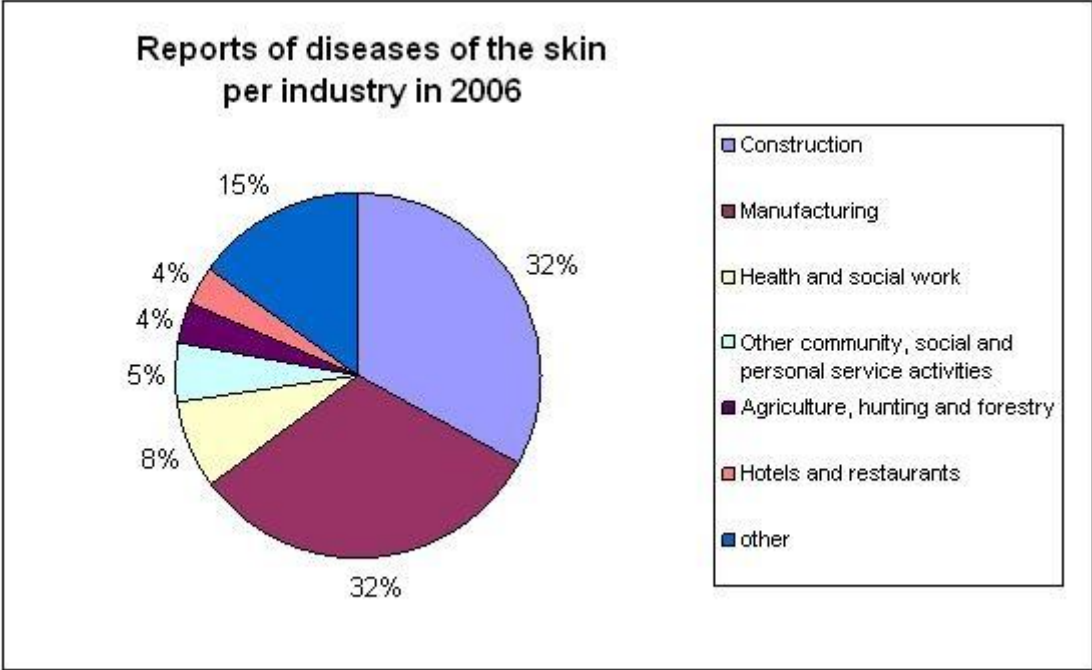
This figure shows the number of skin disorders in the National Registry of Occupational Diseases per age group in 2006.

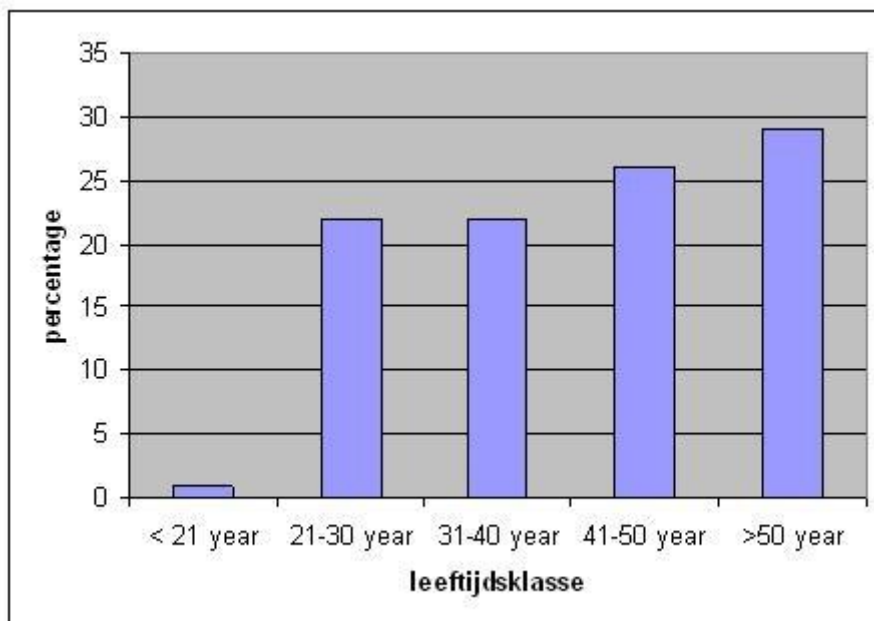

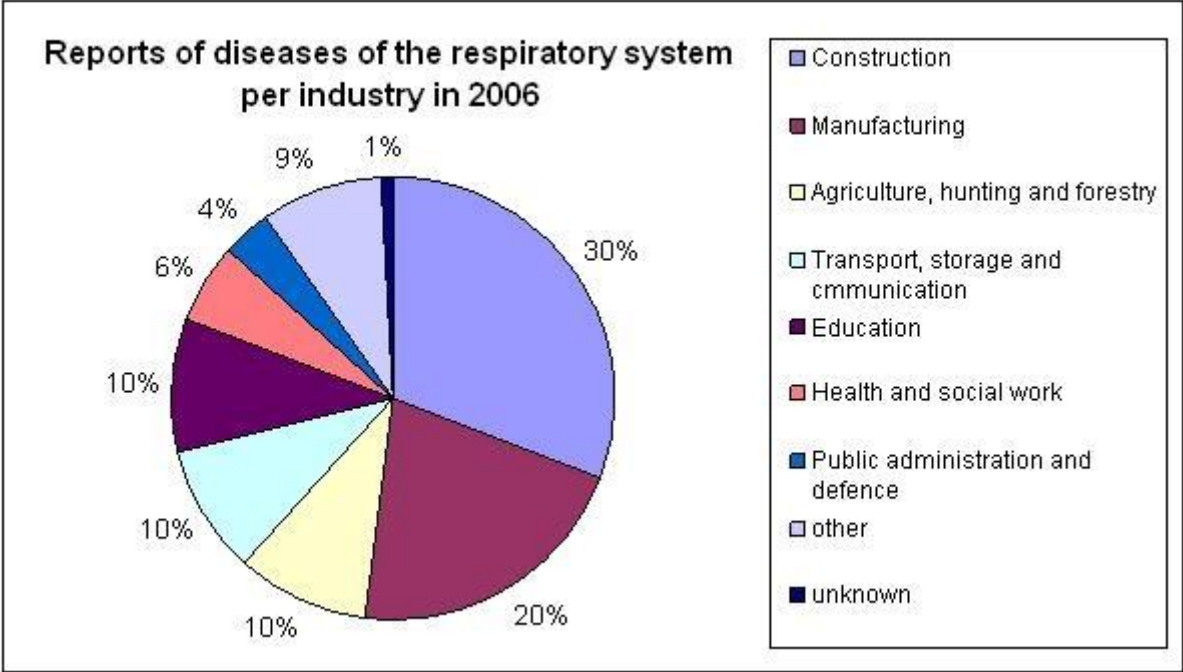
This figure shows the number of reports of lung disorders in the National Registry of Occupational Diseases per age group in 2006

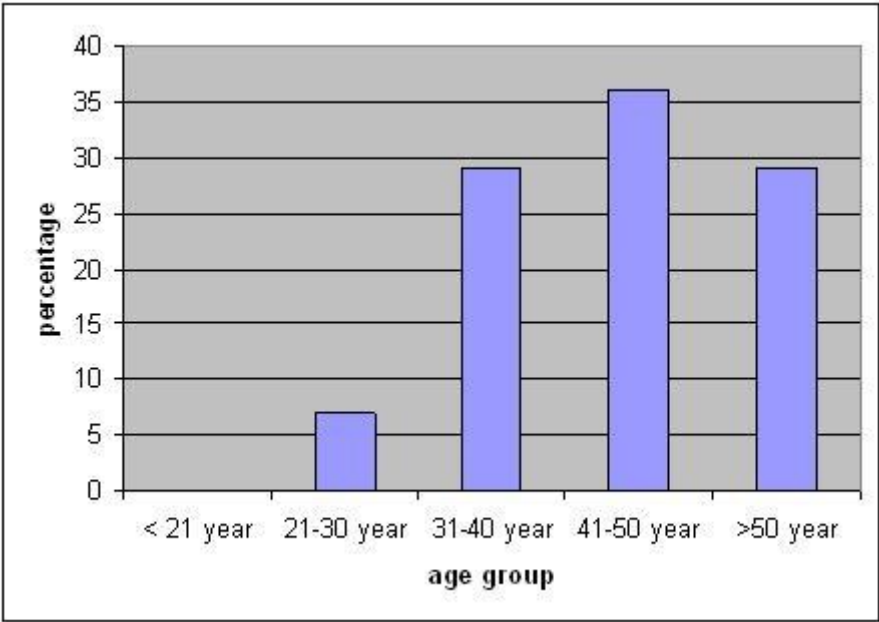

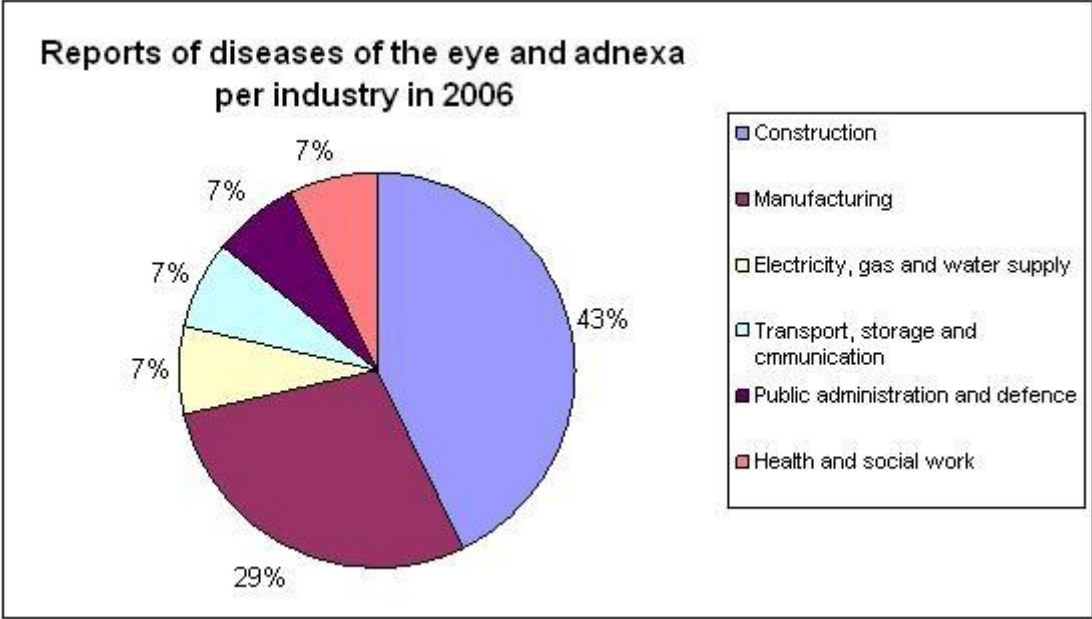
This figure shows the number of reports of diseases of eye and adnexa in the National Registry of Occupational Diseases per age group in 2006

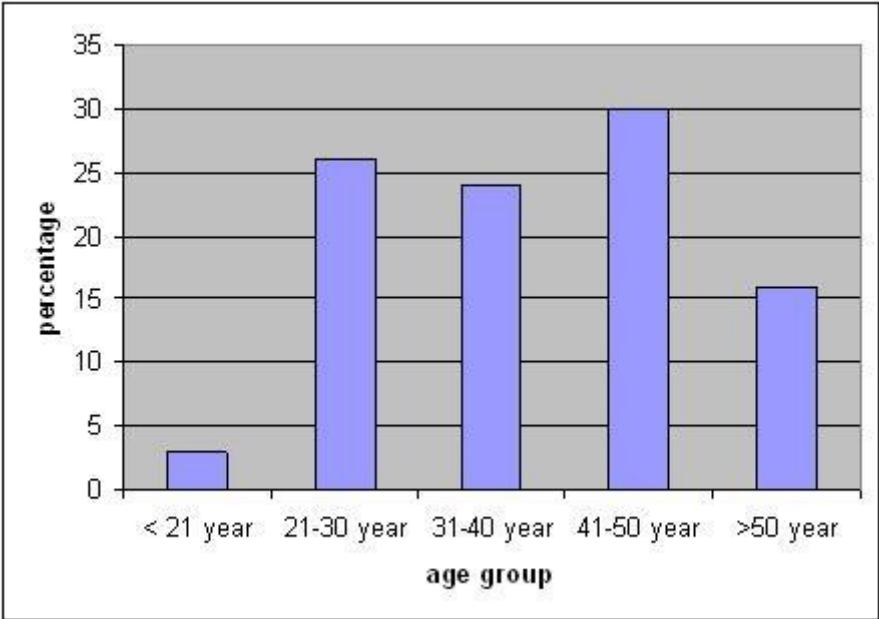

This figure shows the number of reports of infectious diseases in the National Registry of Occupational Diseases per age group in 2006

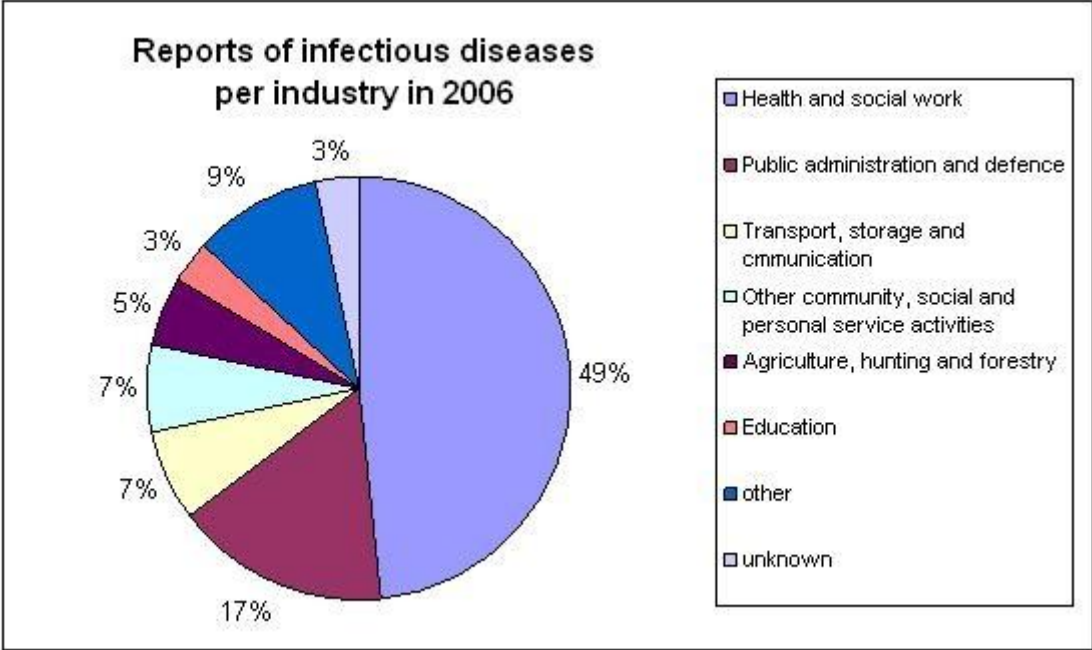
